

ORDER OF THE EXECUTIVE

Re: Application of Laws to Foreshore Act

Enacted under the Application of Laws to Foreshore Act section 3.3

UTO 02/2014

BACKGROUND:

- A. On December 3, 2013, Uchucklesaht Tribe and British Columbia entered into the Foreshore Agreement whereby British Columbia delegated certain lawmaking authorities to Uchucklesaht Tribe over foreshore adjacent to Uchucklesaht lands,
- B. On May 2 2014, Council enacted the Application of Laws to Foreshore Act UTS 30/2014, whereby certain laws of Uchucklesaht Tribe are made applicable to Uchucklesaht foreshore, and
- C. In accordance with section 3.3 of the Application of Laws to Foreshore Act, the Act comes into force by Order of the Executive.

NOW THEREFORE THE EXECUTIVE ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) In this Order, "Act" refers to the Application of Laws to Foreshore Act.
- 2) Subject to section 3.3(e) of the Act, the Act comes into force on the date this Order is enacted.
