Medical Device Reprocessing Technician

MDRTs work closely with registered nurses and support staff to ensure instruments and equipment are ready for use when needed. Our perioperative units are state-of-the-art and allow our multidisciplinary teams to provide a comprehensive array of services across the Island.

PATHWAY:

- 1 HEALTHCARE SETTING:** MDRT perform a variety of duties in hospitals and surgical clinics such as cleaning, sorting, assembling, and picking of simple and complex types of instrument sets and equipment used in the Operating Room (O.R.) and other areas of the hospital. They wrap and sterilize instruments and equipment utilizing a variety of sterilization techniques.
- 2 Education:** Enrolled as a **medical device reprocessing technician student** in a post-secondary institution offering for 5-6 months. Some Institutes have on-line platforms with in-person lab/workshops held on Vancouver Island. Some institutions have reserved seating for Indigenous students.
- 3 Practicum:** Consolidating learning as a **MDRT practicum student** in Island Health Hospital MDR departments throughout Vancouver Island. Choose the location to match your lifestyle while making a difference to patients.
- 4 Credentials for hiring:** Met the institutional competency and practicum requirements by attaining a minimum grade of 70% - 75%.
